To achieve this a quality staff has been comprised of current and former college coaches with Regional ODP experience. Additional professional coaches and collegiate goalkeepers will also be on staff. Collegiate goalkeepers will be utilized by coaching and demonstrating the different techniques and tactics to be used at the camp. The groups at the camp will have a low player/coach ratio. Each group will be divided according to skill and age level to make sure each player is in a training group that will challenge their ability and improve them as a goalkeeper.

The two years Bristol spent at the collegiate level his goalkeepers were ranked in the top 12 in the country in goals against average at the Division 1 level.

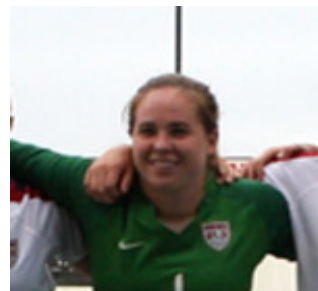

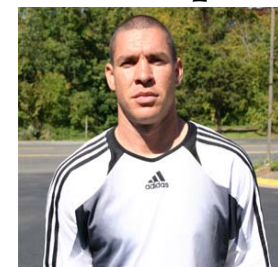
